RE: Informational Update: Resolution Copper Mining Pre-Feasibility Activities Plan of Operations

Dear Chairman Rambler:

As you may know, I was recently promoted to work in Resolution Copper's Communications group as a Native Affairs Coordinator. It will help me to learn more about what concerns the Tribal Council has about our project and also to talk with our People about the project.

In the past our Engineering group has sent the Chairman's Office updates on what we're doing with our studies and other progress. They have asked me to continue that practice by passing along their information and following up to see if there are any questions I can answer, things I can explain, additional information I can provide or if I can help resolve any potential conflicts with the Tribe's activities.

I am not an engineer so will pass along the information as they gave it to me. It's our scheduled activities for the coming six months beginning in April:

Resolution Copper's activities will continue under the Pre-Feasibility Activities Plan of Operations as follows over the next six (6) months:

Drilling and Pumping Activities

- Core rig currently operating at Site M will move to site 4E in April and remain at that site.
- Completion of a 60 to 90 day pumping test at HRES-20, site H-F April – June
- Completion of a 7 to 14 day pumping test at HRES-02, site #2 in July
- Completion of a 7 day pumping test at HRES-05, state land in September
- Commence 28 day pumping test at HRES-19, state land in October.

I have included a map of the activities area.
