

Reclamation and Rehabilitation

Great progress has been made reclaming the historic Magma Mine site. To date, the teams have safely excavated an area covering more than 13 acres of mine impacted soils. The excavated soils are being placed within the tailings storage facility which is also in the process of being closed and reclaimed.

The projects are being undertaken by local contractors Oddonetto Construction of Globe and Superior Environmental of Superior.

Resolution Copper is ahead of this year's schedule reclaiming and rehabilitating the historic Magma Mine site.




Local employment in the Copper Triangle region.

2016 - DOLLARS SPENT WITH LOCAL COMPANIES






PERMITTING

EIS scoping is complete under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Issues identified during scoping are being analyzed by the U.S. Forest Service in order to shape the formal environmental review. Additional information may be obtained at resolutioncopper.eis.us.

Public scoping was initiated on the Apache Leap Special Management Area. An environmental analysis (EA) level of NEPA will be completed before the Special Management Area can be finalized.





INVESTING IN THE COMMUNITY

Key agreements:

1. Town of Superior Emergency Services Agreement:

Under the auspices of the Emergency Services Agreement, the Superior Police Department made improvements to its K9 Unit training program. The department upgraded four of its patrol vehicles and anticipates that it will add three new emergency vehicles in the coming months.

Through Q3, more than \$270,300 donated to 50 local groups and organizations, including 26 academic sholarships.
