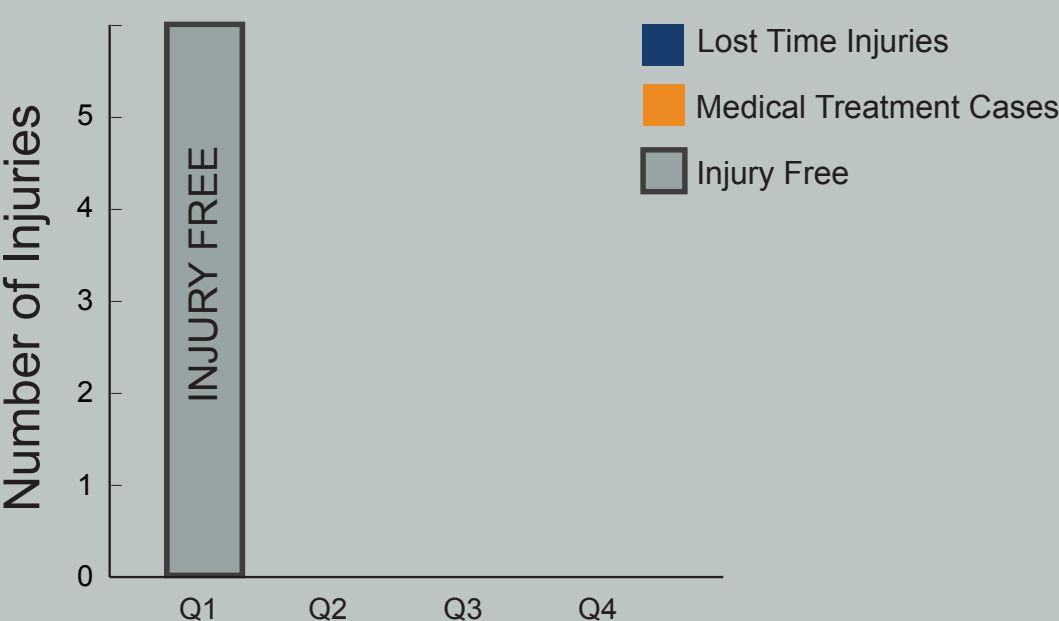

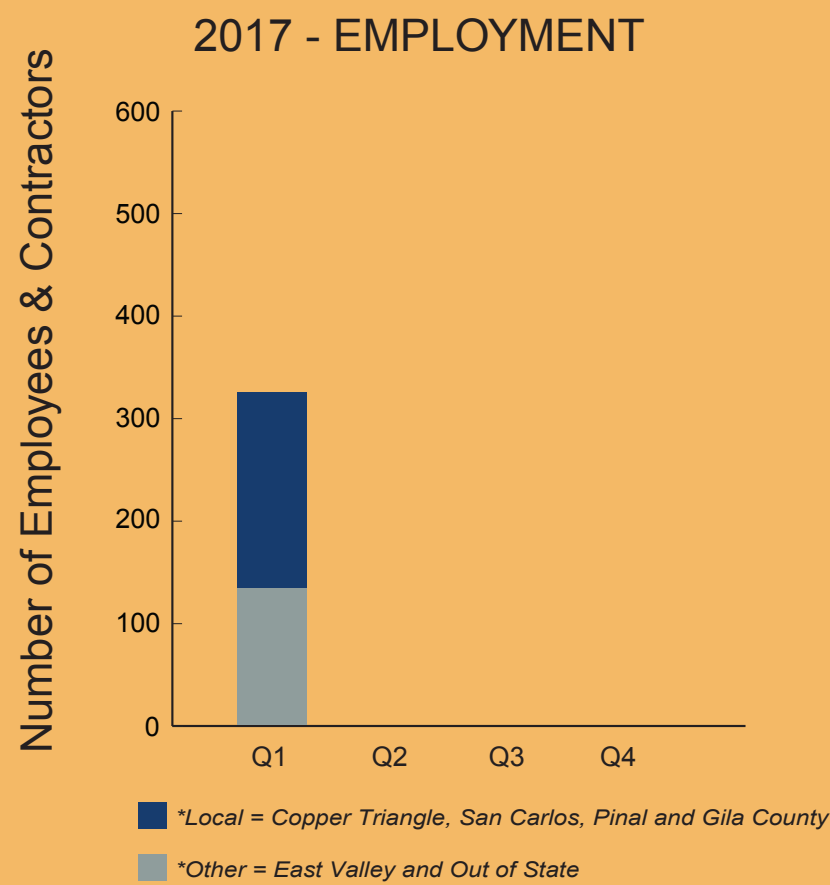
## Safety KEEPING OUR WORKFORCE SAFE

### Reclamation and Rehabilitation

In Quarter 1, Odonetto Construction of Globe made significant progress reclaiming three areas of the smelter impacted soils at the West Plant site. The next phase of this reclamation project includes revegetation.

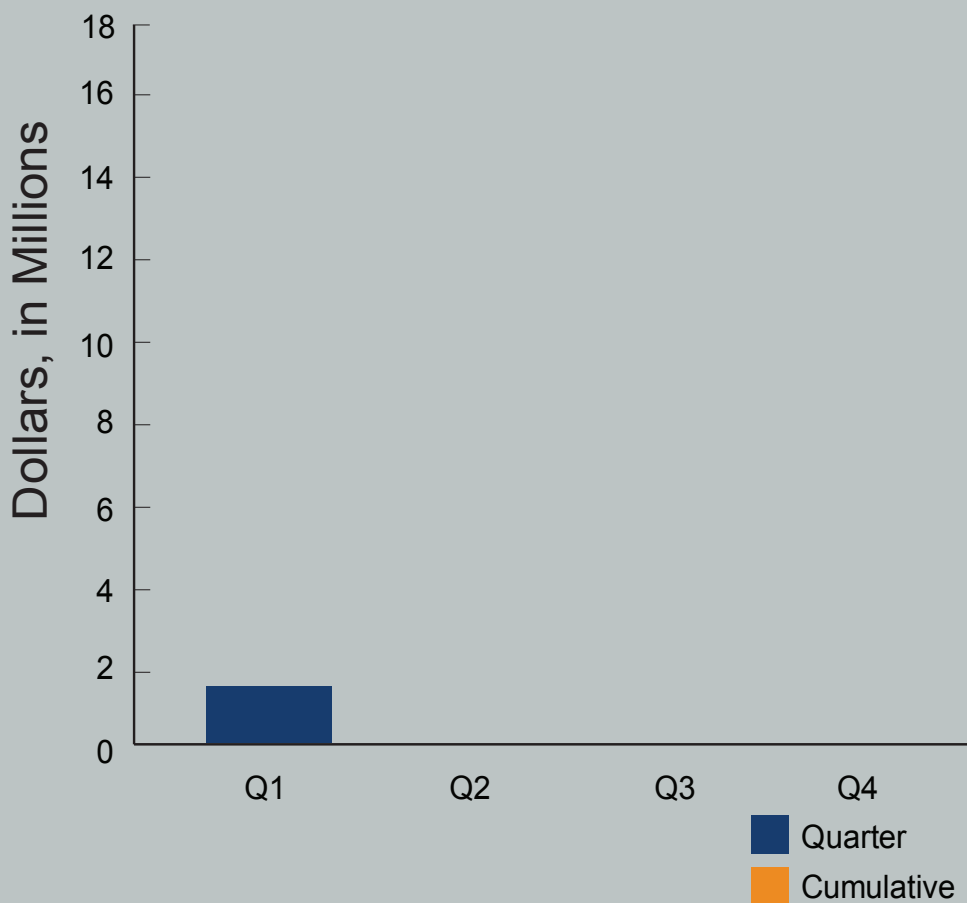
We will also begin further reclamation of the current stormwater collection pond, CP-105.

The Community Monitoring Program (CMP) conducted its first water sampling in February. In collaboration with the Community Working Group and Southwest Groundwater, the group conducted testing of groundwater quality in the local area near the Queen Creek wash. CMP members will meet in May to review and discuss the results as well as conduct their next groundwater sampling.

### 2017 - DOLLAR SPEND WITH LOCAL BUSINESS

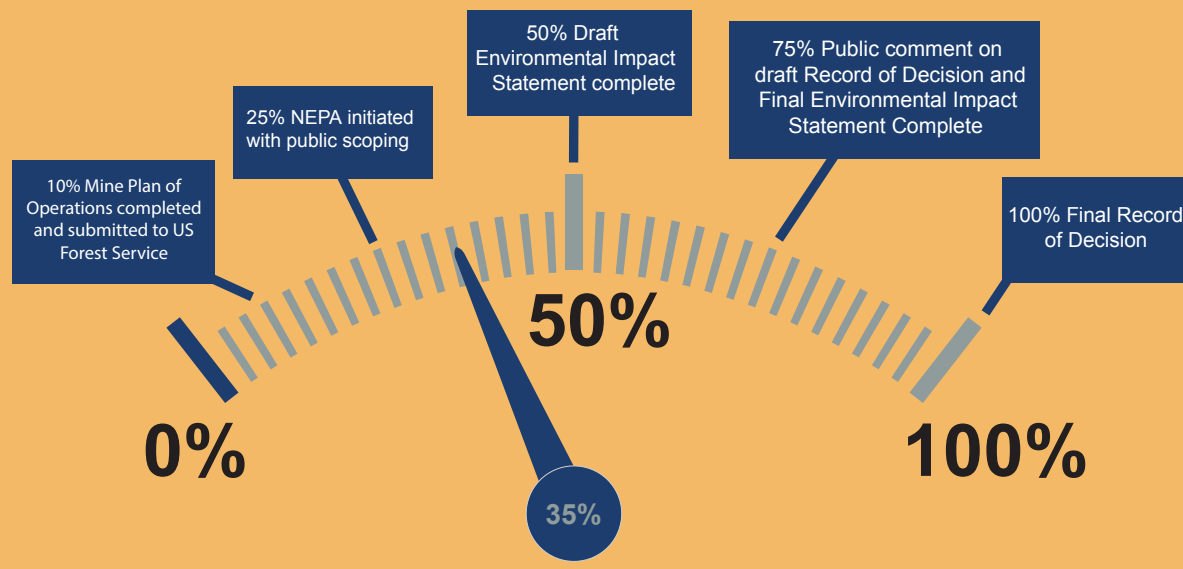


## Growth PERMITTING

EIS scoping is complete under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Issues identified during scoping are being analyzed by the U.S. Forest Service in order to shape the formal environmental review. Separately, a public scoping was initiated on the Apache Leap Special Management Area. The US Forest Service held two public meetings and workshops for the public. The scoping comment period is open from March 17 through May 1, 2017.
