***RE: Informational Update: Resolution Copper Mining Pre-Feasibility Activities Plan of Operations***

Dear Chairman Rambler:

Consistent with my last letter dated October 11, 2013 I am writing to you to provide an update on our exploration and baseline data collection activities related to the pre-feasibility plan of operations (#03-12-02-006).

As described in my prior letters, our Engineering group has asked me to provide this information and I am following up to see if there are any questions I can answer, anything that I can explain, additional information I can provide or if I can help resolve any potential conflicts with the Tribe's activities.

Please see below Resolution Copper's scheduled activities for the upcoming six months beginning in April:

Drilling and Pump Test Activities

- One core rig is currently operating at Site A and will remain during the period
- One core rig currently operating at Site OF-3 and will remain during period
- One rotary rig for pre-collar drilling is currently operating at Site 4E, will move to 4W, then Site D and finish operations during period
- One core rig will mobilize to Site 4E in May
- One core rig will mobilize to Site 4W in June
- With the exception of quarterly monitoring there will be no hydrological pump test work on National Forest Service land for the next 6 months. All drilling and testing will be conducted on state and private land during 2014.
