Dear Chairman Rambler:

Consistent with my last letter dated April 15, 2013 as you may know I work in Resolution Copper's Community group as a Native Affairs Coordinator. It has helped me continue to learn more about what concerns the Tribal Council has about our project and also to talk with our People about the project.

As described in my prior letter, in the past our Engineering group has sent the Chairman's Office updates on what we're doing with our studies and other progress. They have asked me to continue that practice by passing along their information and following up to see if there are any questions I can answer, things I can explain, additional information I can provide or if I can help resolve any potential conflicts with the Tribe's activities.

Please see below Resolution Copper's our scheduled activities for the coming six months beginning in October:

Resolution Copper's activities will continue under the Pre-Feasibility Activities Plan of Operations as follows over the next six (6) months:

Drilling and Pump Test Activities

- Core rig currently operating at Site B, will move to site 4W in October and remain at that site.
- No further pump test work is scheduled at this time for the next 6 months
